

Voice over IP Group

Voice over IP telephony is the new delivery mechanism for making voice calls. Services use a broadband connection to provide voice calls via an IP phone, a special adaptor connected to a traditional phone handset or a personal computer with a headset.

With the new technology offering increased features and benefits to end users, telecoms providers are now selling these services to end users in earnest.

The FCS VoIP Group was set up in April 2006 to represent and support companies delivering or seeking to deliver VoIP services to the residential and business markets. The group will help new entrants to establish their businesses and to provide a collective view into Ofcom on the regulation of this market.
