Billing Forum – 30 March

- Creating a dashboard of info:
 - 82% of billable items are billed – dashboard will show %age of billed items disputed and %age of disputed then credited.
- Events can only be back billed 6 months, other WLR (rentals, connections) up to 12 months
- SFVA and SFI – differences in billing, group looking for alignment – QBC v checklist
- QBC gives absolute decision, no scope for NAs

Pre-SMF – 12 April

- “Trusted to deliver” – internal OR process that allows agent to take issues off line
- Still concerns about Premium Business Help desk performance – lack of ownership
- DSO trial – process has restarted, there have been no volume issues, only quality
- OR have a template of info that should be provided for DSO cases.

Pre-SMF

- Gatekeeper process for complaints is coming back – allows for collection of further info
- 45% of volume complaints (portal) initially rejected – 23% subsequently accepted
- Initial plans to allow more self serve for complaints MIS, via SI “got mixed up with VMJ” now underway again

SMF – 12 April

- Work stacks under control during March – set back by storm Katie, but now recovered
- Missed appointments at lowest ever:
 - Provision 2-3%, repair 3-4%
 - Still aiming for <2%
- Propensity to call – stable on repair, falling on provision
- PCA improving with the exception of ISDN2

SMF

- View my Job and contact routing pilot underway for launch 7 June.
- VMJ = improved order tracker. Provision only, on portal
- Contact routing generates screen pop to correct agent for call

SMF

- Planned system outages to test disaster recovery:
- The windows for the cutovers are:
- 22:00 Saturday 30 April to 06:00 Sunday 1 May (Live to Backup)
- 22:00 Saturday 7 May to 06:00 Sunday 8 May (Backup to Live)

CFPCG – 13 April

- Long reach VDSL proof of concept planned on 200 existing FTTC lines over 2km from DSLAM
- 18/2 special offer due to start 15 June, for lines currently under 3mbps. Cab list to be published
 - £4/mth rental + £15 connection charge
- Harmonised Repair – more complex than expected – deferring planned June launch – possible phased launch

CFPCG

- FTTP trials going well, includes FTTP for Business trial in Bradford (Listerhills and Kirkgate)
- NGA2 trial – 540 orders completed
- FOD2 14 orders completed
- VME – plan to enable for non-appointed L2C (even though there is no visit required)

FCS Fraud Group

- Mark of Excellence – view that standard needs to be outputs based, with no links to specific platform or system
- Fraud Hub –
 - Cifas likely to be too expensive
 - Group considered top options for reporting requirements
 - Alerts v interrogation – push/pull system
 - Draft spec for access and infrastructure by end April to create a tender document

DCR Outputs

- Broadband – looking at what a USO should be
- Mobile coverage obligations coming in
- More minimum standards for OR to attain
- Service quality performance data for all CPs with automatic compensation for consumers and small businesses
- Options for Openreach – enhanced functional separation or wholly owned subsidiary of BT

DCR Outputs

- Clearer advertising (to consumers) of costs and speeds for Broadband services
- Review of the General Conditions – FCS considers this needs to be root and branch – not just a spring clean

Broadband USO - CFI

- Govt intent to give everyone a right to a broadband connection with a download speed of 10Mbps
- Looking at:
 - Specification
 - Demand
 - Cost/proportionality
 - Designating the universal service provider(s)
 - Funding and market distortions
