FITAS

FCS Installers Training & Accreditation Scheme

- Based on FCS 1362
- Replaces Silver Award Scheme for Installers
- Scope includes cellular, business radio and telematics
- Details announced in November 2008
- Live from January 2009

FITAS

- Accreditation is for individual installers
- Ongoing programme of training and assessment
- Initial accreditation requires successful completion of core training modules
- Subject to regular assessment including “live” audit

FITAS

Training programme will offer optional and specialist modules

- Blue Light
 - Public transport
 - Telematics
 - Petroleum Regulations



FITAS

- Widespread support from manufacturers, installers, fleet sector, blue light, government and regulator
- Initial batch of “Patrons” signed up and listed on FCS website
- First applications from installers
